TOURNAMENT RULES



PSi strictly adheres to the FIH indoor rules for all PSi Events

Playing up & down

- -No player may play up or down without permission
- -Teams will be deducted match points if found guilty and the opposition will receive full points (5 points)
- -Permission to play up or down can only be granted by the
- -Tournament Director
- -Only special cases will apply

Cards

- -3 Yellow cards = 1 game suspension
- -1 Red card = minimum 1 game suspension
- -Once the player has been sent off they must sit at the tech table.
- they are not allowed to sit with the team (they may join the team at half time only)
- -The umpire/tech table can immediately award a penalty corner if found guilty
- -If a player receives 3 yellow cards or 1 red card an immediate
- disciplinary hearing will take place.
- -The Tournament Director or authorized PSi staff member will hear both parties and make the final decision.

Swearing

If a player is found guilty the umpire can penalize the player with an automatic yellow card

Time Allocations & Start of games

- -Games will start on time as per fixtures.
- -Matches will consist of 2 halves of 15 to 20 minutes each way with a 2 minute half time break.
- -There will be a 3 to 7 minute break between matches.
- -Time will be kept by the tech table.
- -Time will not be stopped at any time during the match, unless there is a severe medical emergency.
- -If a 2nd ball goes on a court during a match and if influences play, the game will be stopped and will restart with a bully.
- -The whistle will be blown from the tech table on time to start the game regardless if teams are on the court
- -If only one team is ready and the whistle has been blown they may play freely towards the goals AFTER waiting for a period of 30 seconds
- -All FIH indoor rules will apply
- -Goalkeeper substitutions Goalkeepers need to be substituted within 3 metres of the centre line.









TOURNAMENT RULES



Blood Bin

-In the case of a blood injury, players must get off the court immediately and seek medical attention.

Drinks

- -Players may not drink on the court at any stage (this includes halftime)
- -The umpire/ tech table has the right to award a penalty corner should a team be found guilty

Warm up

- -Teams must please warm up outside the hall before games.
- -Please note that there is limited time between matches so coaches must make sure captains toss prior to the start of the game.

Advancing to play-offs

- -Should teams end on the same points after preliminary matches are completed, goal difference will apply to determine who progresses.
- -If goal difference is a tie, then it goes to goals for.
- -If goals for is the same, then the result against each other will apply.

Playoff matches ending in a draw

- -No golden goal policy will apply
- -Show downs will replace penalty flicks if games end in a draw.
- -Each team will nominate 3 players to take a 1v 1 "7 second" attack

Long Corner

 -A long corner will be taken on the half way line and in line with where the ball went out on the base line.

POINT SYSTEM

- 4 Points for a win
- 2 Points for a draw
- 1 Point for losing by 1 goal
- 1 Point for scoring 5 goals or more in a game
- A maximum of 5 points can be achieved per game









SPECIAL CONDITIONS

Tournament behaviour off the court

A player will be suspended from ALL matches based on the following criteria:

- -Use of alcohol, drugs & cigarettes
- -Caught stealing
- -Use of fire crackers
- -Fighting with opposition teams
- -Three daily warnings for misbehaviour at the accomodation

A player will be suspended from 1 game based on the following daily criteria:

- -Making a noise after lights out
- -Playing loud music
- -Back chatting the hotel manager or PSI staff
- -Lights on after lights out without a valid reason
- -General misbehaving in the hotel
- -The above conditions are non negotiable. This is a simple and fair solution which is monitored by the Event Co Ordinator.
- -All matters are reported back to the Event Co Ordinator and your tour manager.
- -In severe cases you will be sent back home at your parents expense.


Indemnity

Due to the nature of the sport, PSi or any of their staff members are not responsible for any losses, damage or injury of any participant caused during the duration of the tournament.









SPECTATOR CODE OF CONDUCT

Indoor hockey is an exciting, fast and entertaining game. Coaches, players and spectators should remember that the objective is to have fun and develop hockey skills. It is important at PSi that all participants conduct themselves in a positive and responsible manner.

PSi will not tolerate behaviour which brings the game into disrepute. The attitude shown by spectators toward the coaches, the umpires, the opposing players are of paramount importance.

PSi has never been all about winning. Inappropriate comments or actions by adults at youth sports undermines the essence of competition and introduces stresses which are inappropriate for young players.

Parents & Spectators should:

- Encourage players to have fun at all times. Focus on praise and encouragement rather than on criticism and negative yelling. The role of the parent is to support the players not coach them. Instructions from too any sources can lead to confusion and stress. A player should not have to deal with a coach, teammates and parents all yelling at them to do something on the field. They should be encouraged to make their own decisions and learn from them.
- Applaud good plays by players on both teams.
- · Encourage fair play and good sportsmanship.
- Spectators must remember that every player on the team is a contributing player. Indoor hockey is a team sport and without each player, there is no team.
- After the game is over, ask the players "Did you have a fun?" or "what did you do well or learn?" and not "who won?" or "who scored?"
- · Attempt to reduce the pressure of competition, not increase it.
- Be kind and respectful to coaches. Spectators to support the coach and his or her decisions and will refrain from verbal criticism during any game. Remember, the coach makes the final decision regarding players on the field, voicing contrasting opinions to youth players during competition undermines the coach and can create issues.
- Do not publicly question the umpire's judgement, and never his or her honesty. The umpires are symbols of fair play, integrity and sportsmanship. Please remember, many of these umpires are young adults learning themselves, so please treat them with respect. There are no full time professional hockey umpires in SA. It is an amateur sport. Umpires like players don't have perfect games so there will be errors which they will learn from.
- NEVER enter the field to speak with an umpire. Speak to your coach or manager if you
 have a concern. If a parent confronts an umpire during or after a game they may be
 asked to leave the venue by a PSi official.
- Accept the results of the game. Encourage your child to be a good sport in victory and in defeat. Many times a player will not remember the results of a game an hour later but they will remember how they felt because of their own – and others actions.
- Parents/Spectators will only sit in designated areas around the field. Sitting along either end line or with the coaches and players is not allowed.



SPECTATOR CODE OF CONDUCT

- Drinking, smoking, foul language and firearms are not allowed around the fields during games or practices. If you need to smoke, please find an area a significant distance away from all other parents, players, and coaches outside of the venue.
- · Appealing at umpires from the stands is not permitted.
- Unsportsmanlike behaviour or dissent is not acceptable.
- Interfering with coach or team is also not appropriate.
- Any sort of discrimination or discriminatory remarks is not acceptable and if identified will result in a disciplinary hearing.
- Accepting Incorrect decisions supporters must understand that there will be human error – bringing video evidence to try show and umpire made a mistake is not appropriate. Unless offering video referral technology for all teams at the tournament the showing of videos will not be entertained. There is no VAR at youth sporting events. The umpires decision on the field of play is final and needs to be accepted.

Failure to comply with the Spectator Code of Conduct could result in the following.

Technical officials as well as umpires at their discretion may card the team captain. The officials may also ask the offending person to leave the venue. If necessary a disciplinary hearing with the head of the franchise may be called to discuss the matter with tournament officials and decide on an appropriate course of action.

Decisions and actions by the tournament officials are final.






